Q1. In Part III - Submission ID of the Submission Uptake Forms, a description of how the proposal and developer meet definitions for Offshore Wind Energy Generation and Offshore Wind Developer, respectively, are required. Can you please point us to where we can find these definitions?

Offshore Wind Energy Generation – Electricity generated exclusively from offshore wind resources residing in leased wind energy areas (WEA) off the coast of North Carolina. Specifically, the eligible generation will be generated by offshore wind generation facility(ies) within an outer continental shelf offshore wind energy lease area regulated by United States Bureau of Ocean Energy Management specified as lease areas OCS-A 0508, OCS-A 0545 and OCS-A 0546.

Offshore Wind Developer – For the purposes of Part III – Submission ID of the Submission Uptake Form, Offshore Wind Developer should be considered the same as Eligible Participants as defined on page 4 of the ARFI.
